



The Cyclone Hockey School will offer on-ice training sessions on Saturdays throughout the summer of 2010. The camp is conveniently located just 30 miles north of Des Moines in Ames, Iowa on the beautiful campus of Iowa State University.

On-ice instruction will be provided by coaches and players from the current Cyclone hockey team as well as other experienced high-level coaches.
